

This time is still different for France

- Coming down to earth: The sun was shining on France and President Emmanuel Macron in 2017. This year, the sky has turned cloudier. With softer-than expected economic growth and only moderate job gains, Macron's policies have increasingly drawn criticism. Unpopular measures (ie higher taxes for pensioners and lower speed limits) and ill-judged decisions such as his belated reaction to the misbehaviour of his bodyguard Benalla irritated many voters. His approval rating collapsed from 64% in June 2017 to 29% in September 2018.
- Another French Icarus flying too close to the sun? Macron's fall from grace is not unusual. For his two predecessors, voter satisfaction plunged in a similar way over the first 15 months of their presidencies. Due to his alleged "Jupiterian" governance style, some observers claim that he does not connect well with "ordinary" voters.
- "It's France": Over the last three decades, various French presidents have risen to the sky with ambitious plans to reform the country before diving into the sea after failing to deliver these plans. Sceptics thus argue that France is unreformable, suffering from specific traits that make serious progress almost impossible. Having fallen silent in 2017 these voices have become louder again this year.
- Macron stays the course: We expect Macron and his reform agenda not to suffer Icarus's fate. Instead, we think there is a high likelihood that he will prevail, unlike his predecessors. Despite obstacles, Macron still drives an ambitious reform agenda. Notwithstanding occasional irritations within the political party he founded himself, he can still count on a comfortable majority of loyal MPs in parliament.
- **Key reforms until 2019, some gifts from 2020 onwards:** After introducing his seminal labour code reform and scaling up previously planned corporate tax cuts in late 2017, Macron managed a controversial overhaul of the SNCF railways this year and made some tweaks to the unemployment insurance, professional training and education systems. Next on his agenda are changes to the welfare state system. The 2019 budget brings further tax cuts to make it more attractive to companies to hire and for workers to accept a job. Although his initial schedule for a sweeping reform has slipped, Macron continues to work towards a major overhaul of the pension system.
- This time is still different: Last year's economic and political tailwinds have turned into headwinds. Macron is experiencing some turbulence. Higher oil prices, recent strikes, some fiscal tightening and trade war concerns are restraining demand growth. However, Macron has not veered far off course. Unlike his predecessors, he has already pushed through some significant changes and will likely deliver more even if he may have to water down some of his plans. Pro-growth reforms take time to show results, as they did in the UK after the Thatcher reforms almost 40 years ago and in Germany following the "Agenda 2010" reforms of 2003/2004.
- No reform drive is perfect but it does not have to be: As long as Macron can achieve a critical mass, his reforms can work. We maintain our call that the results of his reforms will manifest themselves in stronger trend growth and healthy employment gains over time, paving the way for a French "golden decade".
